



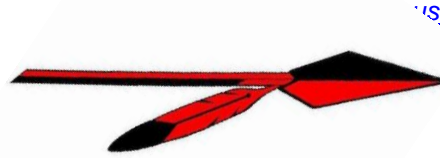

Take the FCPS School Quality and Perceptions Survey

Everyone has a voice in Frederick County Public Schools. That's why we're asking parents and guardians, school-based staff, and students in grades 5-12 to share their candid feedback through our School Quality and Perceptions Survey which will be conducted March 19-April 6.

The survey will ask for feedback on school quality, student and academic support, safety and behavior, school leadership, family involvement, and more. The results will help us determine how well we have addressed the areas for improvement identified through the 2016 School Quality and Perceptions Survey as well as our current strengths and areas in need of focus.

Frederick County Public Schools has partnered with independent research and communications firm K12 *Insight* to administer the survey and compile the results. Your responses are strictly confidential and anonymous.

Please check your email for an invitation and link to the survey later this month. You will also be able to access the survey through the school division's website. Students will take the survey at school. Paper surveys will be available in the school office.

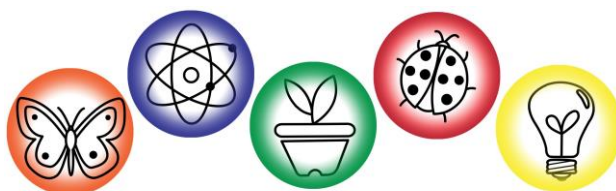

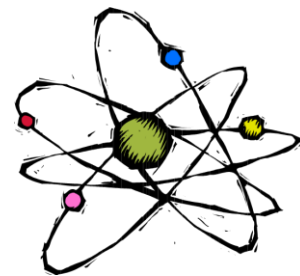

TESTING

AP Testing

All students taking Advanced Placement (AP) exams this year will take the exams at Lord Fairfax Community College. Students who register to take an AP exam will be provided with the specific location to which they should report at LFCC prior to the exam being administered.

Administering AP exams at a central location instead of each individual high school allows more students at each school to take the exams. Students taking the AP exams will have to provide their own transportation to LFCC and will not be counted as absent at their home school on the day(s) they take their AP test(s). Registration for AP tests will be held in the guidance department between February 20 and March 15. AP exams will be administered during the two-week exam window of May 7-11 and May 14-18.
