## **FCPS Launches New Parent/Student Information Portal**



Over the summer, Frederick County Public Schools replaced Edline with a new student information system from Tyler Technologies called Parent/Student 360. The new system will provide parents with access to a variety of information including student schedules, grades and attendance data. Shortly after the start of the 2016-17 school year, parents will receive a user name and password that will allow them to login to Parent/Student 360 to access information regarding their student(s). ## STUDENT SCHEDULES

Student schedules will be mailed on **Thursday, August 4, 2016**, along with locker assignments. After reviewing your schedule, you may pay fees in the main office between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. Monday through Friday, you may mail payment to the school, you may pay the teacher once school starts, or you may use the online payment system, MySchoolBucks.

## FRESHMAN ORIENTATION

Freshman and New Student Orientation will be held on **Monday, August 15th**, starting at 6:30 p.m. Parents will meet in the auditorium and students will meet in the gymnasium. There will be programs for parents and students along with an opportunity for a tour of the facility. Students will need to bring a copy of their schedule.



## BACK-TO-SCHOOL NIGHT

Back to School Night is scheduled for **Wednesday, August 31<sup>st</sup>** from 6:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m. This night is set aside for parents to meet their child's teachers and walk through their class schedule. Parents will need to have a copy of their child's class schedule with them for the evening. This evening is designed as a general orientation for parents. It is not the objective of this evening to hold individual parent conferences.

## TEXTBOOK DISTRIBUTION

Students will pick up their textbooks before school starts from the textbook room. Students will need to bring a copy of their schedule with them. Pick-up times are:

- Seniors - August 8 – 9 am to 12 pm  
& 1 pm to 3 pm
- Juniors - August 9 – 9 am to 12 pm  
& 1 pm to 3 pm
- Sophomores - August 11 – 9 am to 12 pm  
& 1 pm to 3 pm
- Freshmen - August 12 – 9 am to 12 pm  
& 1 pm to 3 pm
- Last chance pick-up - Monday, August 15 –  
9:00 a.m. to 12:00 pm  
& 1:00 to 2:30 p.m.

\*\*Textbook pickup will continue through the first week of school during lunch periods only.



## PARKING PERMITS

Seniors may come to Sherando on **Monday, August 8<sup>th</sup>** from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon to purchase and select their parking space and choose a locker. Juniors may come on **Tuesday, August 9<sup>th</sup>** from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon to purchase and select a parking space. Any student wishing to purchase a parking permit must have their car registration and their driver's license with them at the time of registration. The cost of a parking permit is \$75.00. It is important to remember that student parking spaces and locker assignments can only be chosen by a parent or the student. If you will be on vacation during the above mentioned dates, you may secure your parking space by coming to the administrative office of the school between 8:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. any time after August 9<sup>th</sup>.

## STUDENT ACCIDENT INSURANCE

For the students' protection, if medical insurance is not currently provided through the parents' employer or individual plans, parents are strongly encouraged to purchase insurance from a private vendor or the student accident insurance program available through the school division vendor—The Young Group, Inc. Information about plan types and enrollment instructions can be found online. Go to your child's school website, click on Parents and Students then Health Services then Student Accident Insurance, where plan information and enrollment instructions are located. Enrollment and claim forms are also available in each school office. Frederick County Public Schools' insurance plan does NOT provide medical coverage for accidents or injuries to students during school or during school-sponsored extracurricular activities.
