FCPS Secondary and Middle School Science Fair

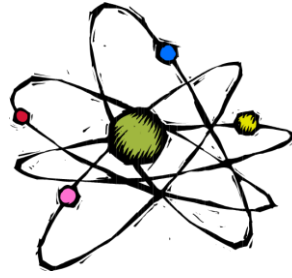
Lord Fairfax Community College

Senior college bound students:

- Be sure to check the Sherando website in the School Counseling link, found under Parent/Student Info, for scholarships. There are many listed there for which you may qualify.
- Remember to file a FAFSA as soon as possible. The link is also found on the School Counseling link.

Seniors who plan to attend LFCC:

- If you haven't applied yet, do it soon.... The LFCC Scholarship is now open but you can't apply for the scholarships until you apply to the school.

Juniors college bound students:

- Now is the time to sign up to take your SAT or ACT tests. Start thinking of schools you would like to visit and possibly apply to.

All students will be registering for their classes for the next school year starting on January 17th. Verification letters will be sent home at a later date.

- Member of the month for December was Brittany Driver.

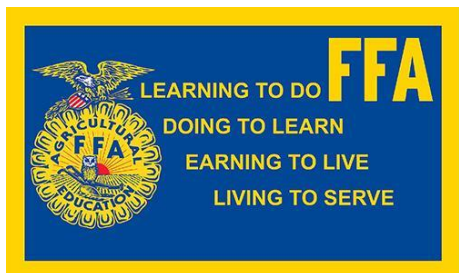
National Convention Teams
